



Airdrie's population growth over the last 40 years





Water and Wastewater Infrastructure with Calgary

Airdrie requires an additional wastewater line and new lift station to convey wastewater to Calgary by 2028 ~ \$100 Million

Airdrie also requires a new waterline from Calgary to provide redundant water supply by 2032 as well as two new water reservoirs in Airdrie ~ \$100 Million
